**Accepted:** Batteries; Tires: \$3 without rims, \$4 with rims

**Not Accepted:** Motors, large appliances, curbside recyclables and hazardous waste

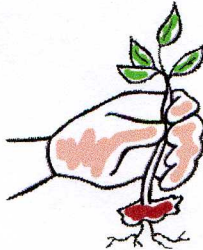

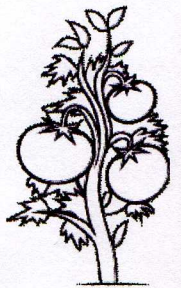


## COMMUNITY GARDENS COMING TO BROOKLYN

The Oregon Dept. of Transportation (ODOT) has approved our proposal to build a community garden at their lot located just south of SE Franklin Street at SE McLoughlin Boulevard. We're planning on installing raised beds, a fence, stairs, terraces, a shed, a sign, and water spigots with guidance from ODOT's landscape department. The Brooklyn Neighborhood will maintain the site. Thanks to BAC board member Jacob Heil for spearheading this project.
