LAWNS MORE THAN 10 INCHES HIGH?

Portland has installed a pilot program that lets residents not only complain but get something done about neighbors' overgrown lawns. Homeowners who fail to mow their lawns could be fined \$233 monthly. Send a digital photo uploaded to the city's website: http://www.portlandonline.com/bds/index.cfm?c=53112. The homeowner will receive a notice to clean up the property or pay the fine.

Additional information from the website: Due to limited resources, complaints may only be submitted online. This pilot project only addresses tall grass and weeds in excess of 10 inches in height. Other nuisance conditions such as blackberry overgrowth and trash & debris are not addressed under this pilot project. Due to reduced resources, complaints are being prioritized and not all complaints are able to be investigated at this time.

FIGHT THE BITE: DON'T BREED MOSQUITOES AND PROTECT BROOKLYN FROM WEST NILE VIRUS

The following are some effective things you can do to eliminate mosquito breeding sites:

- Remove standing water in ponds, ditches, gutters, flower pots, puddles, tires and cans.
- Check unusual items that might contain water such as wheelbarrows and toys. Turn them upside down to prevent collecting water.
 - Check water in birdbaths and wading pools WEEKLY for mosquito larvae. Better yet, change the water.
- Stock ornamental ponds and fountains with fish that eat mosquito larvae or treat them with BTI, a natural bacteria that kills larvae. This can be purchased at garden and home stores or feed and supply stores.

One of the scheduled CSA drop-off points is at The Warehouse Cafe (home of Portland Green Parenting) on SE Milwaukie Ave.

Growers Alliance farmers grow vegetables at three sites in SE Portland and Damascus, using all organic practices with no sprays or synthetic fertilizers. They're now accepting members for their Fall season CSA box. Joining is a great way to receive fresh produce grown only a few miles away and to help new and disadvantaged farmers in the area.
