Sacred Heart Catholic Church announced the official opening of their new Fellowship Hall June 28, 2019. After a year of construction, the doors are finally open to parish events, wedding and funeral receptions as well as service clubs and educational programs.

The hall will seat 250 occupants, complimented with a fully functional kitchen for large groups; it also boasts a state of the art sound and video system.

Located in the basement is a large space for St. Vincent dePaul Food Pantry. Sacred Heart actually has the largest SVDP pantry in SE Portland and food is distributed on a regular basis.
