Welcome, introduction, and land acknowledgement

Introductions of non-board members

Stephen Hayes, resident since 1991, safety concerns brought him to the meeting

Josh reads the land acknowledgement

Land acknowledgement: We start this event by acknowledging that Multnomah County is geographically located on the ancestral homelands of the Indigenous tribes of the Multnomah, Kathlamet, Clackamas, Tumwater, Watlala bands of the Chinook, the Tualatin Kalapuya and many other Indigenous nations of the Columbia River. We recognize that Indigenous/Native American communities still exist today despite intentional attempts of genocide, displacement, and assimilation by white supremacy culture and systems.

While land acknowledgements are important in helping us frame a sense of place and history, we recognize that they are only the first step towards reconciliation.

Marie's neighbor, Christina, who is a "master recycler", asking for lightly used electronics, clothes (wearable or recyclable), scrap metal, no paint. She'll be there to help sort through it.

David

Safety issues discussion, particular events described.

New attendee, Steven, invited to comment on safety events. Odd events at one particular event around SE 11th.

John recommends reporting zoning and other violations.

Guy has talked about complaining to the property owner about improperly parked vehicles.

David recommends recording the activities.

Guy and Steven will sit down to talk about chatting with the owner.

Later discussion about the neighborhood mailman who's having a hip replacement.

Code of Conduct draft.

General discussion of the processes around it, from informally addressing violations to formal escalations.

Stuart asks a question about the committee: might be good to add someone external to the board officers on the committee, possibly a SEUL member or general member.

Melaney talks about how to work around the number of folks on the committee and how to work it when external folks aren't available. Also asks for gender balance considerations.

Josh offers to remove the part that calls out the precise members of the committee, Melaney suggests that the board select the committee when they are elected to ensure the members wish to serve.

David talks about the pressures of lockdown and expresses sorrow over any past transgressions. Marie says it has been part.
