In that spirit we thank everyone for respecting each other at this table, for giving them the space to express themselves, and for devoting ourselves to paying close attention to each voice.

Land Acknowledgement

Likewise, read aloud

We start this event by acknowledging that Multnomah County is geographically located on the ancestral homelands of the Indigenous tribes of the Multnomah, Kathlamet, Clackamas, Tumwater, Watlala bands of the Chinook, the Tualatin Kalapuya and many other Indigenous nations of the Columbia River. We recognize that Indigenous/Native American communities still exist today despite intentional attempts of genocide, displacement, and assimilation by white supremacy culture and systems.

While land acknowledgements are important in helping us frame a sense of place and history, we recognize that they are only the first step towards reconciliation.

 - It was relayed to the board while the CoC team acknowledges that in this case there was a single event that caused harm, failure to apologize (initially or with prompting) was not consistent with the concept of respect as outlined in the CoC
 - Gratitude was given to the CoC Team for their work
 - Reminder that while CoC team makes recommendations to the board for final action they are able to take temporary actions as needed based on situations
